****ECTS(European Credit Transfer System)***

Many European universities issue credits per ECTS guidelines, or in both their own systems and ECTS. Per ECTS, 60 credits represent the workload of an academic year of study. At Rensselaer, the following guidelines are used with regard to the transfer of ECTS credits: 10 ECTS = 5 Rensselaer credits; 5 ECTS = 3 Rensselaer.
