ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. *A minimum of three Focus Area Electives must be at the 4000 level.*
2. *The 4 credit History/Theory requirement must be completed by the end of the first year of the program.*
3. *Selected topics courses (Topics in the Arts) may be taken to fulfill the Focus Area Elective requirements.*
4. *Two independent studies (Studies in the Arts may be taken to fulfill Focus Area Elective requirements with adviser approval.*
