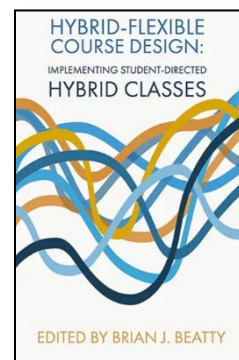
The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment to Host a “Tips and Tricks” Lunch and Learn Series featuring Rensselaer Faculty
